SCREENING TO CARE

For the benefit of all students.



Screening to Care (S2C) is a school based initiative offered by PFCS within Vista Unified School District. Funding is provided by the County of San Diego.

Using *mySAEBRS* screening results, we identify and determine school community and student social-emotional need and connect students to appropriate level of care using the multi-tiered system of supports framework. We also accept referrals from school staff and parents for student involvement in Tier 2 or 3 services.

Tier 1 The School Community & Classroom

We recommend areas of focus to classrooms and the entire school to build positive relationships and a supportive atmophere for all students.

Tier 2 Small Group Lessons & Check-Ins

We use the Second
Step curriculum in
small groups and
individual check-ins
to help students build
skills - like nurturing
positive relationships,
managing emotions,
and setting goals — so
they can thrive in
school and in life.

Tier 3

Individual Supports & Care Coordination

For students who require more formal indiviualized supports, we offer limited care coordination and connect students and their families to behavioral treatment.

Promotoras: Promoting and Supporting S2C.

Promotoras enhance the connection between parent / caregivers and schools.

They link families to needed community resources.

They build bridges between the school and community to develop a shared responsibility for student success.
